Traffic Shift on Southbound State Road (SR) 826

Miami — On Friday morning, February 3, traffic on southbound SR 826 will be shifted to the right between SR 836 and West Flagler Street. In order to prepare for the shift, the following closures will occur Thursday night, February 2 between 9:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

One lane on southbound SR 826 will be closed between 9:30 p.m. and 11:30 p.m.

Eastbound SR 836 ramp to southbound SR 826 will close between 9:30 p.m. and 11 p.m. Drivers can:

- Exit at NW 72 Avenue, turn north
- Enter westbound SR 836
- Access southbound SR 826 via right hand loop ramp

West Flagler ramp to southbound SR 826 will close between 9:30 p.m. and 11 p.m.

- Drivers on westbound West Flagler Street can:
 - Turn south on NW 87 Avenue
 - Turn east on SW 8 Street to access SR 826
- Drivers on eastbound West Flagler Street can:
 - Turn south on NW 72 Avenue
 - Turn right on Tamiami Canal Road
 - West on SW 8 Street to access SR 826

Southbound SR 826 ramp to West Flagler Street will close between 9:30 p.m. and 11 p.m. Drivers can:

- Continue south on SR 826
- Exit at SW 8 Street, head west
- North on SW 87 Avenue to access West Flagler Street

All southbound lanes on SR 826 will close from NW 12 Street and West Flagler Street between the hours of 11:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:

- Take the westbound SR 836 ramp and exit at NW 87 Avenue/ NW 12 Street
- West to NW 87 Avenue
- Make left at NW 87 Avenue to access eastbound SR 836
- Take the southbound SR 826 ramp

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
