Nighttime Closures of State Road (SR) 826

Miami, FL – The following closures will be implemented to work on a bridge over the roadway and sign panels:

All northbound travel lanes on SR 826 will be closed at NW 25 Street Monday, December 21 and Tuesday, December 22, between the hours of 11:45 p.m. and 5 a.m.:

- Drivers on northbound SR 826 will be diverted to the NW 25 Street exit ramp
- Continue north through NW 25 Street and enter the northbound SR 826 entrance ramp

All southbound lanes on SR 826 will be closed at the NW 25 Street exit on Tuesday, December 22, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Southbound drivers on SR 826 can:

- Exit at NW 25 Street, west to NW 87 Avenue, go south on NW 87 Avenue
- Enter the eastbound SR 836 ramp lanes to access the southbound SR 826 ramp

Southbound drivers on SR 826 going to eastbound SR 836 can:

- Exit at NW 25 Street, west to NW 87 Avenue, go south on NW 87 Avenue
- Enter the eastbound SR 836 ramp

Southbound drivers on SR 826 going to westbound SR 836 can:

- Exit at NW 25 Street, west to NW 87 Avenue, go south on NW 87 Avenue
- Enter the westbound SR 836 ramp at NW 12 Street

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
