## **FDOT to Host Public Meeting for a Roadway Improvement Project**

*State Road (SR) 922/NW 125 Street from NW 6 Court to NE Miami Court*

---

**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation District Six (FDOT) will conduct a public meeting for a roadway improvement project along SR 922/NW 125 Street from NW 6 Court to NE Miami Court, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in December 2018 and last about 10 months. The estimated construction cost is \$3.7 million.

A public meeting will be held **from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday, January 14, 2016 at the City of North Miami Council Chamber Room, 2 Floor, 776 NE 125 Street, North Miami, FL 33161**. The meeting will be an open house, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed work for this project includes:

- Widening of I-95 southbound off ramp to provide a left turn lane
- Converting the westbound inside thru lane to a left turn lane to turn into southbound NW 6 Court
- Widening the road and adding a westbound right turn lane at NW 6 Avenue
- Relocating and installing traffic signals at NW 6 Avenue and NW 6 Court
- Installing eastbound and westbound left turn lanes at NW 2 Avenue
- Constructing raised concrete islands at NE Miami Court, NW 1 Avenue and NW 4 Avenue to restrict left turn movements from the side streets and along NW 125 Street
- Upgrading traffic signals at North Miami Avenue
- Improving drainage
- Relocating existing light poles
- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Removing landscape
