Closure of Southbound State Road (SR) 826 at NW 25 Street

Miami, FL — All southbound lanes on SR 826 will be closed at the NW 25 Street exit on Thursday, January 14 and Monday, January 18 through Wednesday, January 20, between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. to allow the contractor to install an overhead sign structure and sign panels.

Southbound drivers on SR 826 can:

- Exit at NW 25 Street, west to NW 87 Avenue, go south on NW 87 Avenue
- Enter the eastbound SR 836 ramp lanes to access the southbound SR 826 ramp

Southbound drivers on SR 826 going to eastbound SR 836 can:

- Exit at NW 25 Street, west to NW 87 Avenue, go south on NW 87 Avenue
- Enter the eastbound SR 836 ramp

Southbound drivers on SR 826 going to westbound SR 836 can:

- Exit at NW 25 Street, west to NW 87 Avenue, go south on NW 87 Avenue
- Enter the westbound SR 836 ramp at NW 12 Street

The NW 25 Street ramp to southbound SR 826 will be closed on Thursday, January 14 and Monday, January 18 through Wednesday, January 20, between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Eastbound drivers on NW 25 Street going south on SR 826

- Continue east on NW 25 Street, south on Milam Dairy Road
- West on NW 11 Street to access SR 836 west ramp
- Take turn around ramp to West Flagler Street/SR 826 south

Westbound drivers on NW 25 Street going south on SR 826

- Continue west on NW 25 Street to NW 87 Avenue, go south on NW 87 Avenue
- Enter the eastbound SR 836 ramp lanes to access the southbound SR 826 ramp

If weather or any other unforeseen conditions affect the closures, they will be scheduled on the next available night.
