FDOT to Conduct Work on Summerland Key

January 16 to January 18

Monroe County, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), through its Asset Maintenance contractor, HDR/ICA, will be conducting work at MM 24.7 on Summerland Key over the Martin Luther King holiday weekend to stabilize a soil settlement in the FDOT right-of-way near the Summerland Key Post Office.

This work has been scheduled for a time when the post office is closed in order to minimize disruption to normal operations. Substantial impact to US 1 traffic is not expected, although cars may be briefly stopped to allow trucks to safely enter the roadway.

Work is scheduled to begin on Saturday afternoon, January 16 and is expected to be completed by Monday afternoon, January 18.
