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NW 36 Street Closed for Railroad Crossing Repairs

Miami, FL – Beginning at 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 6, 2016 until 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 9, 2016, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) will close the railroad crossing located on NW 36 Street (between NW North River Drive and NW 37 Court) for these days, weather permitting. During this time, all traffic will be detoured away from NW 36 Street and directed to follow signs to alternate local streets.

This detour is being established to allow workers to perform necessary repairs to the South Florida Rail Corridor. During the closure, workers will replace the existing tracks and crossing surface to improve ride quality.

Traffic traveling westbound on NW 36 Street will be directed to turn left onto NW 36 Avenue, then to turn right onto NW North River Drive and then to turn left back to NW 36th Street.

Traffic traveling eastbound on NW 36 Street will be directed to turn right onto NW North River Drive, then to turn left onto NW 36 Avenue and then to turn right back to NW 36 Street.
