Lane and Ramp Closures on Westbound State Road (SR) 836

Miami, FL – The following closures will be implemented to allow the contractor to pave the roadway:

Three westbound SR 836 lanes will be closed from Thursday, March 10 through Wednesday, March 16, between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.

The westbound SR 836 ramps to NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road, West Flagler Street and NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street will be closed on Saturday, March 12 and Sunday, March 13 (Monday, March 14 is an alternate date), between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Westbound drivers on SR 836 going to NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road and West Flagler Street:

- Go north on SR 826, exit at NW 25 Street
- East on NW 25 Street, south NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road
- Continue south to West Flagler Street

Westbound drivers on SR 836 going to NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street can:

- Go north on SR 826, exit at NW 25 Street
- East on NW 25 Street, south NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road
- West on NW 12 Street to NW 87 Avenue

The westbound SR 836 ramps to SR 826 north and south will be closed on Monday, March 14 and Tuesday, March 15 (Wednesday, March 16 is an alternate date) between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:

- Exit at NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road, go west on NW 11 Street
- Enter the westbound SR 836 ramp to access the SR 826 north or south ramp

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
