Closure of State Road (SR) 836 Ramp to West Flagler Street and NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street

Miami, FL – The following closures will be implemented to allow the contractor to place asphalt on the roadway:

The westbound SR 836 ramp to West Flagler Street and NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street will be closed on Tuesday, March 29, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Westbound drivers on SR 836 going to West Flagler Street:

- Exit at NW 72 Avenue, west on NW 11 Street
- South on Milam Dairy Road to connect with West Flagler Street

Westbound drivers on SR 836 going to NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street can:

- Exit at NW 72 Avenue, west on NW 11 Street
- North on Milam Dairy Road, west on NW 12 Street to NW 87 Avenue

Drivers on Milam Dairy Road going to westbound SR 836 can:

- Go north on Milam Dairy Road, west on NW 12 Street
- Access the westbound SR 836 entrance ramp after NW 87 Avenue

Drivers on Milam Dairy Road going to southbound SR 826 can:

- Go north on Milam Dairy Road to NW 25 Street, west on NW 25 Street
- Access the southbound SR 826 entrance ramp

The Milam Dairy Road ramp to southbound SR 826 and westbound SR 836 will be closed Tuesday, March 29 through Thursday, March 31, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Drivers on Milam Dairy Road going to westbound SR 836 can:

- Go north on Milam Dairy Road, west on NW 12 Street
- Access the westbound SR 836 entrance ramp after NW 87 Avenue

Drivers on Milam Dairy Road going to southbound SR 826 can:

- Go north on Milam Dairy Road to NW 25 Street, west on NW 25 Street
- Access the southbound SR 826 entrance ramp

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
