Nighttime Lane Closures of Northbound State Road (SR) 826 and Ramp to West Flagler Street/Milam Dairy Road/NW 72 Avenue

Miami, FL – The northbound SR 826 ramp lane to West Flagler Street/Milam Dairy Road/NW 72 Avenue will be closed on Wednesday, April 20 through Friday, April 22 and Sunday, April 24, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:

- Exit at NW 25 Street, east on NW 25 Street
- South on NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road to West Flagler Street

The West Flagler Street ramp to northbound SR 826 will be closed on Wednesday, April 20 through Friday, April 22 and Sunday, April 24, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:

- Go north on NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road
- Turn west on NW 11 Street to access the northbound SR 826 entrance ramp

Up to four northbound lanes will be closed from SR 836 to NW 25 Street on Thursday, April 21, Friday, April 22 and Sunday, April 24, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Drivers on mainline SR 826 going to NW 25 Street will need to exit at NW 36 Street on Sunday, April 24, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:

- Exit at NW 36 Street
- Go **east** to NW 72 Avenue, south on 72 Avenue to connect with NW 25 Street **OR**
- Go **west** to NW 79 Avenue, south on NW 79 Avenue to connect with NW 25 Street
