Closure of Westbound NW 12 Street and NW 78 Avenue at NW 12 Street

Doral, FL – All westbound travel lanes on NW 12 Street between Milam Dairy Road and NW 82 Avenue will be closed starting at 10 p.m., Friday, April 22 until 5:30 a.m., Monday, April 25. NW 78 Avenue will also be closed at NW 12 starting at 10 p.m., Friday, April 22 until 5:30 a.m. Monday, April 25. **Access to local businesses will be provided.**

Drivers on westbound NW 12 continuing west can:

- South on Milam Dairy Road
- Access westbound SR 836 ramp at NW 11 Street
- Exit at the NW 12 Street/NW 87 Avenue ramp

Drivers on NW 78 Avenue going to NW 12 Street can:

- North on NW 78 Avenue, west on NW 15 Street
- South on 79 Avenue, west on NW 14 Street
- South on NW 82 Avenue to connect with NW 12 Street

Drivers on eastbound NW 12 Street going to NW 78 Avenue can:

- North on NW 82 Avenue, east on NW 14 Street
- North on NW 79 Avenue
- East on NW 15 Street to connect with NW 78 Avenue

Drivers on westbound NW 12 Street going to NW 78 Avenue can:

- South on Milam Dairy Road
- Access westbound SR 836 ramp at NW 11 Street
- Exit at the NW 12 Street/NW 87 Avenue ramp, east on NW 12 Street
- North on NW 82 Avenue, east on NW 14 Street
- North on NW 79 Avenue
- East on NW 15 Street to connect with NW 78 Avenue

The closure will allow the contractor to reconstruct the intersection. **Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.**
