Closure of Southbound State Road (SR) 826 Exit Ramps to SR 836 and Milam Dairy Road/NW 72 Avenue and NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street

Miami, FL – The southbound SR 826 ramps to eastbound and westbound SR 836, and Milam Dairy Road/NW 72 Avenue and NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street will be closed on Thursday, April 28 and Friday, April 29, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Southbound drivers on SR 826 going to eastbound or westbound SR 836 can:

- Continue south and exit at the SW 8 Street east ramp
- Enter the northbound SR 826 ramp to access the eastbound or westbound SR 836 ramp

Southbound drivers on SR 826 going to NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road can:

- Continue south and exit at West Flagler Street
- Go east to connect with NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road

Southbound drivers on SR 826 going to NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street can:

- Continue south and exit at West Flagler Street, west to NW 87 Avenue
- North to NW 12 Street

The closure will allow contractor to place asphalt on the roadway. **Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.**
