Update: Nighttime Lane Closures on NW 25 Street

Doral, FL – Below is the updated NW 25 Street Viaduct Project closure schedule beginning on **Tuesday, May 3.**

One NW 25 Street eastbound and westbound lane will be closed from NW 79 Avenue to NW 82 Avenue on Tuesday, May 3 through Friday, May 6, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

There will be rolling lane closures on eastbound and westbound NW 25 Street from NW 89 Court to NW 82 Avenue on Tuesday, May 3 through Friday, May 6, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

The center section of NW 79 Avenue between the eastbound and westbound NW 25 Street lanes will be closed on Wednesday, May 4, Thursday, May 5 and Monday, May 9, between the hours of 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. and Friday, May 6 through Sunday, May 8, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Southbound drivers on NW 79 Avenue continuing south can:

- Go west on NW 29 Street, south on NW 82 Avenue
- East on NW 25 Street to connect with NW 79 Avenue

Drivers on eastbound NW 25 Street going north on NW 79 Avenue can:

- North on NW 82 Avenue
- East on NW 29 Street to connect with NW 79 Avenue

Drivers on westbound NW 25 Street going south on NW 79 Avenue can:

- Go north on NW 79 Avenue
- Go west on NW 29 Street, south on NW 82 Avenue
- East on NW 25 Street to connect with NW 79 Avenue

Access to local businesses will be provided. Please note that if the work is not completed due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions, the closure will occur on the following night.
