Closure of Westbound State Road (SR) 836 at the NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road Exit Ramp

Miami, FL – All westbound SR 836 travel lanes will be closed at the exit ramp to NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road West Flagler Street and NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street on Tuesday, May 24; Wednesday, May 25 and Thursday, May 26, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Westbound drivers on SR 836 continuing west can:

- Exit at the NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road ramp
- Access the exit to NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street
- Continue west on the ramp lanes to connect with mainline westbound SR 836

Westbound drivers on SR 836 going to SR 826 north:

- Exit at NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road, go west on NW 11 Street
- Cross Milam Dairy Road at the signalized intersection to access the northbound SR 826 ramp

Westbound drivers on SR 836 going to SR 826 south:

- Exit at NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road
- Access the exit to NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street
- Follow signs to the West Flagler Street/SR 826 south ramp
