Closure of Milam Dairy Road Ramp to Eastbound State Road (SR) 836 and the Eastbound SR 836 Collector Road

Miami, FL – The following lane closures will be implemented (*weather permitting*) to allow the contractor to pave the roadway:

The Milam Dairy Road entrance ramp to eastbound SR 836 will be closed on Friday, June 3 and Sunday, June 5 through Friday, June 10, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:

• Go east on NW 7 Street, north on NW 57 Avenue to access the eastbound SR 836 ramp

The eastbound SR 836 collector road to eastbound mainline SR 836 will be closed at the NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road ramp on Friday, June 3 and Sunday, June 5 through Friday, June 10, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:

- Exit at the NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road ramp, south on Milam Dairy Road
- Go east on NW 7 Street, north on NW 57 Avenue to access the eastbound SR 836 ramp

If weather or any other unforeseen conditions affect the closures, they will be scheduled on the next available night.
