## State Road (SR) 826 and NW 25 Street Closures

---

*Doral, FL* – Below is the updated NW 25 Street Viaduct Project closure schedule through Wednesday, June 8.

**All southbound travel lanes on SR 826 will be closed at NW 25 Street on Wednesday, June 8, between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.:**

- Drivers on southbound SR 826 will be diverted to the NW 25 Street exit ramp
- Continue south through NW 25 Street and enter the southbound SR 826 entrance ramp

**There will be rolling lane closures on eastbound and westbound NW 25 Street from NW 82 Avenue to SR 826 on Wednesday, June 8, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.**

**Westbound NW 25 Street will be closed from NW 74 Avenue to SR 826 on Wednesday, June 8, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:**

- Go north on SR 826
- West on NW 36 Street
- South on NW 79 Avenue to access NW 25 Street

**The two left turn lanes on the northbound SR 826 exit ramp to go west on NW 25 Street and the eastbound NW 25 Street left turn lanes to the northbound SR 826 ramp will be closed on Wednesday, June 8, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:**

- Go east on NW 25 Street, turn north on NW 72 Avenue, west on NW 36 Street
- Turn south on NW 79 Avenue to access NW 25 Street

**Access to local businesses will be provided.
