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FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for a Safety Improvement Project

State Road (SR) 90/US 41/SW 8 Street from SR 9/SW 27 Avenue to SW 3 Avenue

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation District Six (FDOT) will conduct a public hearing for a safety improvement project along SR 90/US 41/SW 8 Street from SR 9/SW 27 Avenue to SW 3 Avenue.

A public hearing will be held **from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Wednesday July 27, at the Miami-Dade College InterAmerican Campus, 627 SW 27 Ave., Room 401, Miami, FL 33135**. The hearing will be an open house, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. with a formal presentation starting at 6:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the hearing, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.

The proposed work for this project includes:

- Adding 10 mid-block crosswalks
- Upgrading pedestrian detectors and ramps to current standards
- Enhancing existing crosswalk markings
- Providing sidewalk improvements at several locations
- Adding sidewalk along the south side of SW 8 Street between SW 4 Avenue and SW 3 Avenue

Construction is expected to begin in November 2017 and last about eight months. The estimated construction cost is \$2.8 million.
