## Closure of State Road (SR) 826 and SR 836 Ramps

---

*Miami, FL* – The following closures will be scheduled as noted below:

**The West Flagler Street ramp to southbound SR 826 will be closed on Monday, August 22 through Wednesday, August 24 between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.**

**Westbound drivers on West Flagler Street going to southbound SR 826 can:**

- West to NW 87 Avenue
- South to SW 8 Street
- East to SR 826

**Eastbound drivers on West Flagler Street going to southbound SR 826 can:**

- Continue east on West Flagler Street, south on NW 72 Avenue
- Turn right on Tamiami Canal Road to SW 8 Street
- West on SW 8 Street, access the southbound SR 826 ramp

**The southbound SR 826 ramp to SW 8 Street will be closed Monday, August 22 through Wednesday, August 24 between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:**

- Exit at West Flagler Street, west to NW 87 Avenue, south to SW 8 Street

**The westbound SR 836 ramp to West Flagler Street/SW 8 Street/SR 826 south and the southbound ramp lanes to NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road will be closed on Monday, August 22 through Wednesday, August 24 between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:**

- Exit at NW 12 Street/NW 87 Avenue, west on NW 12 Street, south on NW 87 Avenue
- East of West Flagler Street to connect with NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road **OR**
- Continue south on SW 87 Avenue to connect with SW 8 Street

**Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.**
