FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for two Roadway Improvement Projects

*State Road (SR) 997/Krome Avenue from SW 312 Street/Campbell Drive to SW 296 Street and
SW 312 Street/Campbell Drive from SR 997/Krome Avenue to SR 5/US 1*

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public meeting for two roadway improvement projects along SR 997/Krome Avenue from SW 312 Street/Campbell Drive to SW 296 Street and SW 312 Street/Campbell Drive from SR 997/Krome Avenue to SR 5/US 1, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in September 2019 and last for about 33 months. The estimated construction cost for these projects is \$17 million.

The public meeting will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Wednesday, November 16, 2016, at the William F. Dickinson Community Center, 1601 N. Krome Avenue, Homestead, FL, 33030. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss these projects.

The proposed work for these projects include:

Project Number: 405575-6-52-01: SW 312 Street/Campbell Drive from SR 997/Krome Avenue to SR 5/US 1

- Widening of Campbell Drive from west of Krome Avenue to east of US 1
- Reconstructing the roadway from Krome Avenue to US 1
- Providing two 11-foot thru lanes in each direction
- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Upgrading existing traffic and pedestrian signals to current standards
- Installing new drainage and lighting

Project Number: 405575-9-52-01: State Road (SR) 997/Krome Avenue from SW 312 Street/Campbell Drive to SW 296 Street

- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Removing parking and bicycle lanes
- Widening the roadway from SW 300 Street (NW 19 Street) to SW 296 Street to continue through lane
- Improving drainage system
- Enhancing existing traffic and pedestrian signals to current standards
- Upgrading signage pavement markings
