FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for Two Roadway Projects

State Road (SR) 94/SW 88 Street/Kendall Drive from SW 102 Avenue to SW 79 Avenue

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public hearing for two roadway safety projects along SR 94/SW 88 Street/Kendall Drive from SW 102 Avenue to SW 79 Avenue, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in June 2018 and last for about nine months. The estimated construction cost of these projects is \$3.5 million.

The public hearing will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday, January 19, 2017, at the Riverside Baptist Church, Room Fellowship (FH), 10775 SW 104 Street, Miami, FL 33176. The hearing will begin as an open house, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., with a formal presentation starting at 6:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the hearing, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed work for these projects include:

- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Enhancing pedestrian ramps, signage, pavement markings, and lighting to meet the current standards
- Reconstructing sidewalks
- Removing obsolete driveways
- Reconstructing the raised median at Kendall Drive and SW 79 Avenue
- Providing left turns from Kendall Drive onto SW 79 Avenue and right turn in-and-out of north and south SW 79 Avenue
