## **State Road (SR) 916/NW 135 Street**

*Intersection Enhancement Project Begins the Week of January 23*

---

**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin an intersection enhancement project the week of January 23, 2017. The project limits extend along SR 916/NW 135 Street and NW 17 Avenue in Miami-Dade County. The project will cost an estimated \$177,943. The work will take approximately four months to be completed. The project includes the following:

- Removing and installing two new traffic signals
- Installing new reflective borders on signal heads
- Installing an additional signal head on the southbound approach of the intersection
- Installing a “Next Signal NW 135 St.” roadway sign on the southbound approach of the intersection
- Reconstructing pedestrian sidewalks
- Installing new pedestrian signal

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to periodically close lanes. Construction will be done in stages to minimize impacts to the public during special events and peak periods of traffic. The department will make sure traffic continues to flow safely through the work zones.
