FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for Roadway Projects

State Road (SR) 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue from north of SR 934/NW 79 Street to south of Biscayne Canal

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public hearing for three roadway resurfacing projects along SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue from north of SR 934/NW 79 Street to south of the Biscayne Canal, in Miami Dade County. The estimated construction cost of the projects is \$10 million. The construction schedule for each project is listed below:

- **North of SR 934/NW 79 Street to Little River Drive:**
To begin in August 2018 and last about five months.
- **Little River Drive to SR 924/NW 119 Street:**
To begin in January 2019 and last about ten months.
- **SR 924/NW 119 Street to south of Biscayne Canal:**
To begin in May 2020 and last about eleven months.

The public hearing will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday, January 26, 2017, at the Joe Celestin Center, Multipurpose Room, 1525 NW 135 Street, North Miami, Florida 33167. The hearing will begin as an open house, from 6 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., with a formal presentation starting at 6:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the hearing, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the projects.

The proposed work for this project include:

- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Eliminating outside lanes and replacing with on-street parking and bicycle lanes
- Reconstructing sidewalks at signalized intersections
- Improving existing traffic signals
- Upgrading pavement markings, pedestrian signs and signals
- Enhancing existing lighting system at all signalized intersections
- Modifying existing medians and installing medians
