FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for two Roadway Projects

State Road (SR) 5/Overseas Highway from Sugarloaf Key Mile Marker (MM) 19.794 to west of Cudjoe Key MM 20.664 and from east of Cudjoe Key MM 23.121 to Summerland Key MM 25.396

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public meeting for two roadway resurfacing projects along SR 5/Overseas Highway from Sugarloaf Key MM 19.794 to west of Cudjoe Key MM 20.664 and from east of Cudjoe Key MM 23.121 to Summerland Key MM 25.396, in Monroe County. Construction is expected to begin in July 2018 and last for about 11 months. The estimated construction cost of these projects is \$4.6 million.

The public meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Thursday, March 16, 2017, at the Sugarloaf Fire Station, 17097 Overseas, Sugarloaf Key, FL 33042. The meeting will be an open house, from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the projects and answer questions.

The proposed work for these projects include:

- Repaving and minor widening of the roadway
- Upgrading signing and pavement markings
- Adding bicycle markings
- Installing aluminum pedestrian/bicycle bullet railing at bridges
