Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six, has scheduled Public Information Workshops regarding the PD&E study for SR 94/Kendall Drive/SW 88 Street from SR 997/Krome Avenue/SW 177 Avenue to Dadeland North Metrorail Station, in Miami-Dade County. The Kendall corridor is being studied as a part of the Strategic Miami Area Rapid Transit, or SMART Plan, which identifies the development of six rapid transit corridors that directly support the mobility of our future population and employment growth. This study will focus on improving SR 94/Kendall Drive/SW 88 Street through the implementation of a cost-effective, high-ridership new rapid transit service with supporting pedestrian and bicycle facilities. These workshops will provide an opportunity for the public to learn about the project, become familiar with the study process, and provide initial feedback.
