State Road (SR) 9A/I-95 at SR 860/Miami Gardens Drive

Roadway Project Begins the Week of March 27

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway construction project the week of March 27, 2017. The project limits extend along the interchange of SR 9A/I-95 ramps at SR 860/Miami Gardens Drive in the City of North Miami Beach. The project will cost an estimated \$1.3 million. The work will take approximately seven months to be completed. The project includes the following:

- Repaving and restriping the existing roadway
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings
- Widening the roadway and paved shoulders
- Upgrading guardrails
- Replacing electrical boxes
- Replacing underground signal sensors
- Installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) components

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to periodically close lanes. Construction will be done in stages to minimize impacts to the public during special events and peak periods of traffic. The department will make sure traffic continues to flow safely through the work zones.
