Lane Closure Update for I-95 and 95 Express

Miami, FL – The following closures will be implemented to continue shifting the southbound travel lanes between NW 79 Street and NW 60 Street approximately five feet to the right and begin construction of the first emergency stopping site.

Thursday, March 23 - All southbound 95 Express Lanes from the Golden Glades Interchange to State Road (SR) 112 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Monday, March 27, Wednesday, March 29 and Thursday, March 30 - All southbound and northbound 95 Express Lanes from the Golden Glades Interchange to SR 112 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Tuesday, March 28 - All southbound and northbound 95 Express Lanes from the Golden Glades Interchange to SR 112 and one general purpose lane from NW 79 Street to NW 60 Street will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Friday, March 31 and Saturday, April 1 - All southbound and northbound 95 Express Lanes from the Golden Glades Interchange to SR 112 will be closed from 11 p.m. to 11 a.m. the next morning.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the I-95 Design/Build Project to construct five emergency stopping sites on I-95 from NW 62 Street to NW 131 Street, and replace the concrete pavement from NW 29 Street to NW 79 Street.
