## Roadway Project Begins the Week of May 1

*State Road (SR) 90/SW 8 Street at SW 67 Avenue*

---

**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway project the week of May 1, 2017. The project limits extend along SR 90/SW 8 Street at SW 67 Avenue in Miami-Dade County. The project will cost an estimated \$397,288. This project will last approximately four months and includes the following:

- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Updating pedestrian ramps and crosswalks
- Updating pedestrian signals and signage
- Installing street lighting
- Replacing sidewalk in various areas

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes and detour traffic at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

**Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.**
