## Northbound 95 Express Lane Entrance to be Relocated

---

*Miami, FL* – The entrance to the northbound 95 Express Lanes currently located at approximately NW 29 Street will be relocated approximately one mile to the north on Sunday morning, May 7 for a period of approximately two years. All signage will be changed to reflect the new location of the northbound 95 Express entrance.

The relocation of the northbound express lanes entrance will provide the contractor the necessary room required to begin the replacement of the concrete pavement on I-95 between NW 29 Street and NW 79 Street. In order to relocate the entrance, the following closures will be implemented:

Friday, May 5 through Sunday, May 7 (**around the clock closure**) – All northbound 95 Express Lanes from State Road (SR) 112 to the Golden Glades Interchange will be continuously closed starting at 11 p.m. on Friday, May 5 through 11 a.m., Sunday, May 7.

Friday, May 5 and Saturday, May 6 - One northbound general purpose lane from NW 27 Street to NW 79 Street will be closed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m.

The closures will allow the contractor to work on the emergency stopping sites and install temporary concrete barrier walls and lighting. **Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.** The closures are part of the I-95 Design/Build Project to construct five emergency stopping sites on I-95 from NW 62 Street to NW 131 Street, and replace the concrete pavement from NW 29 Street to NW 79 Street.
