FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for a Roadway Project

State Road (SR) 90/SW 152 Street/Coral Reef Drive from Florida's Turnpike to US 1

Miami, FL –The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway construction project the week of May 22, 2017. The project limits extend along SR 992/SW 152 Street/Coral Reef Drive from SR 821/HEFT/Florida's Turnpike to SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway, in Miami-Dade County.

A Public Information Meeting will take place to discuss this project from **6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, May 9, at Palmetto Bay Golf Course Clubhouse, 9300 SW 152 Street, Miami, Florida 33157**. FDOT representatives will provide an overview of the project and will be available to answer questions.

This project will cost an estimated \$2.6 million and will take roughly eight months to complete. The project includes the following:

- Repaving and restriping the road
- Upgrading pedestrian ramps to current standards
- Replacing isolated drainage structures
- Modifying the median at the intersections of SW 102 Avenue and SW 107 Avenue
- Enhancing signalization
- Repairing the bridge deck
- Widening existing westbound outside lane from SW 93 Avenue to 500 feet west of SW 93 Avenue
- Extending eastbound left turn lane at SW 93 Avenue and US 1
- Providing an exclusive left turn lane for the public library
- Modifying the existing driveway entrance at Jackson South Community Hospital
- Installing signage and pavement markings

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events. **Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.**
