FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for a Roadway Project

State Road (SR) 916/NW 135 Street from Cairo Lane to Sesame Street

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public meeting for a roadway safety project along SR 916/NW 135 Street from Cairo Lane to Sesame Street, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in February 2020 and last about three months. The estimated construction cost of the projects is \$372,000.

The public meeting will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Wednesday, June 7, 2017, at Sherbondy Village, Auditorium, 215 N Perviz Avenue, Opa-locka, FL 33054. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.

The proposed work for this project includes:

- Adding signalized midblock crosswalk
- Providing roadway signage and pavement markings
