FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for a Roadway Safety Project

State Road (SR) 9/NW 27 Avenue from NW 23 Street to NW 26 Street

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public hearing for a roadway safety project along SR 9/NW 27 Avenue from NW 23 Street to NW 26 Street, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in February 2020 and last for about five months. The estimated construction cost of the project is \$545,851.

The public hearing will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday, June 8, 2017, at the Juan Pablo Duarte Park, Recreation Building, 2800 NW 17 Avenue, Miami, FL 33142. The hearing will begin as an open house, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., with a formal presentation starting at 6:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the hearing, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed work for this project includes:

- Installing traffic signal and lighting at the intersection of SR 9/NW 27 Avenue and NW 24 Street
- Adding pedestrian and bicyclist warning signs
- Providing pedestrian safety signs and adding crosswalks
- Relocating existing bus stop closer to signalized intersection
- Restricting westbound left turn movements at the intersection of SR 9/NW 27 Avenue and NW 23 Street
- Modifying median along NW 27 Avenue
