I-95 and 95 Express Lane Closures

Miami, FL – The following closures on I-95 and 95 Express will be scheduled as noted below:

Continuous Weekend Lane Closures

Continuous weekend closures will resume on Friday, July 14 after the July 4 Holiday and Major League Baseball Allstar Events.

95 Express Lanes Closures

Wednesday, July 5 and Thursday, July 6 - All northbound 95 Express Lanes from the Golden Glades Interchange to State Road (SR) 112 will be closed nightly between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Wednesday, July 5 through Saturday, July 8 - All southbound 95 Express Lanes from the Golden Glades Interchange to SR 112 will be closed nightly between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

General Purpose Lane and Ramp Closures

Wednesday, July 5 and Thursday, July 6 - Two to three northbound general-purpose lanes from NW 29 Street to NW 50 Street will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. If necessary, the third travel lane will be closed at 11 p.m.

Wednesday, July 5 and Thursday, July 6 - One lane on the northbound I-95 ramp to eastbound I-195 and on the westbound I-195 ramp to northbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Wednesday, July 5 and Thursday, July 6 - One northbound I-95 general purpose lane from NW 125 Street to NW 135 Street will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes when possible. Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the I-95 Design/Build Project to construct five emergency stopping sites on I-95 from NW 62 Street to NW 131 Street, and replace the concrete pavement from NW 29 Street to NW 79 Street.
