State Road (SR) 933/SW/NW 12 Avenue

Roadway Project Begins the Week of July 10, 2017

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway improvement project the week of July 10, 2017. The project limits extend along SR 933/SW/NW 12 Avenue from north of SW 13 Street to NW 20 Street in the City of Miami. The project will cost an estimated \$1.7 million. The work will take approximately nine months to be completed. The project includes the following:

- Repaving and restriping sections of pavement
- Adjusting manhole covers
- Upgrading curb, gutter and pedestrian ramps
- Improving drainage, signing and pavement markings
- Replacing underground signal timing detectors

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to periodically close lanes. Construction will be done in stages to minimize impacts to the public during special events and peak periods of traffic. The department will make sure traffic continues to flow safely through the work zones.
