Intelligent Transportation Systems Project Begins July 14

State Road (SR) 9A/I-95 Corridor from SR 112 to NW 215 Street, SR 826, SR 112, I-395 and at the GGI Park-and-Ride

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin an Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) construction project on July 14, 2017. The project limits extend along sections of SR 9A/I-95 from SR 112 to NW 215 Street, SR 826, SR 112, I-395 and at the GGI Park-and-Ride lot in Miami-Dade County. This project will cost an estimated \$6 million and will take roughly ten months to complete and will include:

Along I-95:

- Replace toll amount and lane status Dynamic Message Signs (DMSs)
- Install additional traffic cameras and upgrade ITS power infrastructure
- Replace the fiber-optic cable along I-95 between SR 112 and GGI

GGI Park-and-Ride lot:

- Replace toll amount and lane status DMSs
- Install Warning Gate System (WGS) at the GGI Park-and-Ride facility entrance ramp to southbound 95 Express

On SR 112:

- Install WGS along eastbound SR 112 to the southbound entrance ramp to 95 Express
- Install WGS and signs along NW 10 Avenue and NW 39 Street northbound entrance ramp to 95 Express

SR 826, I-395 and NW 103 Street:

- Replace incident management DMSs (westbound SR 826 west of NW 17 Avenue, westbound SR 826 west of NW 67 Avenue, and westbound I-395 at Watson Island)
- Replace arterial DMS on eastbound NW 103 Street before I-95

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events. **Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.**
