I-95 and 95 Express Lane Closures for Sign Replacement

Miami, FL – The following closures on I-95 and 95 Express will be scheduled as noted below to allow the contractor to replace Dynamic Message Signs:

Friday, July 14 – The southbound 95 Express Lanes will be closed from Ives Dairy Road to the Golden Glades Interchange between the hours of 11 p.m. and 8 a.m. One general use lane on southbound I-95 from NW 199 Street to NW 191 Street will also be closed during this time frame.

Friday, July 21 – One general use southbound lane on I-95 will be closed from NW 199 Street to NW 191 Street between the hours of 11 p.m. and 8 a.m.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the I-95 Design/Build Project to replace Intelligent Transportation Systems Devices (ITS) such as Toll Amount and Lane Status Dynamic Message Signs, Incident Management Dynamic Message Signs and cameras. The project will also install a Warning Gate System at the entrances to the 95 Express Lanes at the Golden Glades Park-and-Ride lot as well as SR 112.
