## **State Road (SR) 823/NW 57 Avenue/West 4 Avenue/Red Road Reconstruction Project Completed**

*Project Final Accepted on July 5, 2017*

---

**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has officially completed the SR 823/NW 57 Avenue/West 4 Avenue/Red Road Reconstruction project on Wednesday, July 5, 2017. The project extended along SR 823/NW 57 Avenue/West 4 Avenue/Red Road from West 53 Street to West 84 Street/NW 138 Street/NW 135 Street. It started on January 5, 2015, and featured approximately \$41 million in roadway, drainage, pedestrian and signalization enhancements that included:

- Widening and reconstructing the roadway to provide additional travel lanes
- Installing a water main
- Installing raised medians
- Installing new drainage systems
- Reconstructing existing sidewalks and curb ramps and installing new ones
- Installing lighting and signalization
- Installing a barrier wall
- Reconstructing curb and gutter
- Landscaping

This Red Road project marks the completion to a series of FDOT reconstruction and widening projects along Red Road that began in 2009, starting at Okeechobee Road in the City of Hialeah. All projects have been completed with the goal of enhancing mobility, relieving congestion and creating a safe corridor for vehicles, bicyclists and pedestrians.
