Traffic Shift on SW 152 Street/Coral Reef Drive

Miami, FL – On Monday morning, July 31 (Tuesday morning, August 1 is an alternate date), all traffic on SW 152 Street/Coral Reef Drive from just west of SW 93 Avenue to just west of SW 97 Avenue will be shifted to the north side of the roadway. The westbound and eastbound travel lanes will remain one lane in each direction and shifted to the north side of the roadway. This traffic pattern will be in effect for approximately five weeks to allow the contractor to repair and resurface the south section of the bridge over the C-100 canal.

In order to prepare for the traffic shift, there will be alternating single lane closures on Coral Reef Drive/SW 152 Street from SW 93 Avenue to SW 102 Avenue on Sunday, July 30 (Monday, July 31 is an alternate night), between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. One lane on southbound US 1 will also be closed at SW 152 Street on Monday, July 31, between the hours of 5:30 a.m. and 9 a.m.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
