## **State Road (SR) 997/SW 177 Avenue/Krome Avenue**

*Drainage Project Begins the Week of August 28, 2017*

---

**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a drainage improvement project the week of August 28, 2017. The project limits extend along SR 997/SW 177 Avenue/Krome Avenue at the C-102 Canal located north of SW 200 Street in Miami-Dade County. The project will cost an estimated \$1.9 million. The work will take approximately one year to be completed. The project includes the following:

- Relocation of existing South Florida Water Management Drainage Control Structure S-194 over the C-102 Canal

There are no lane closures anticipated as part of this project. In the event of a lane closure, information will be posted on the department's website. The department will make sure traffic continues to flow safely through the work zones.
