FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for a Roadway Project

State Road (SR) 25/Okeechobee Road at W 16 Avenue

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public meeting for a roadway project along SR 25/Okeechobee Road at W 16 Avenue, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in March 2019 and last four months. The estimated construction cost of the project is \$535,145.

The public meeting will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, August 29, 2017, at the Town of Medley, Second Floor, 7777 NW 72 Avenue, Medley, FL 33166. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed work for this project include:

- Extending the SR 25/Okeechobee Road southbound left-turning lane
- Repaving and restriping the intersection
- Adding a concrete median
- Enhancing traffic signals and pavement markings
