State Road (SR) 112/I-195/Julia Tuttle Causeway

Roadway Project Begins the Week of October 9, 2017

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a bridge rehabilitation project the week of October 9, 2017. The limits of the project extend along SR 112/I-195/Julia Tuttle Causeway over Biscayne Bay (bridge number 870302) in Miami-Dade County. The project will cost an estimated \$1.5 million. The work will take approximately 10 months to be completed. The project includes the following:

- Cleaning, repairing and painting bridge steel structures
- Repairing concrete deck, beams and columns, including installing corrosion control to structures

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to periodically close lanes. Construction will be done in stages to minimize impacts to the public during special events and peak periods of traffic. The department will make sure traffic continues to flow safely through the work zones.
