I-95 and 95 Express Lane Closures for Sign Replacement

Miami, FL – The following closures on I-95 and 95 Express will be scheduled as noted below to allow the contractor to replace Dynamic Message Signs:

Friday, October 13 - The entrance to the Golden Glades Park and Ride facility and access to NW 7 Avenue from northbound FL-9 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 8 a.m. Drivers can:

- Continue north on FL-9, turn right on NW 2 Avenue
- Turn right on NW 157 Street, turn left on NW 6 Avenue
- Turn right on NW 151 Street to access NW 7 Avenue
- Turn right on NW 7 Avenue to access the Golden Glades Park and Ride Facility

Saturday, October 14 - The southbound 95 Express Lanes will be closed from Ives Dairy Road to the Golden Glades Interchange between the hours of 11 p.m. and 8 a.m. Two general use southbound lanes on I-95 will also be closed from Ives Dairy Road to NW 196 Street during this time frame.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the I-95 Design/Build Project to replace Intelligent Transportation Systems Devices (ITS) such as Toll Amount and Lane Status Dynamic Message Signs, Incident Management Dynamic Message Signs and cameras. The project will also install a Warning Gate System at the entrances to the 95 Express Lanes, the Golden Glades Park and Ride Facility as well as SR 112.
