FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for two Roadway Projects

State Road (SR) 934/Normandy Drive at Rue Granville and Rue Vendome

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public hearing for two roadway projects along SR 934/Normandy Drive at Rue Granville and Rue Vendome, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in September 2019 and last five months. The estimated construction cost for these projects is \$795,277.

The public hearing will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, October 24, 2017, at the North Shore Park and Youth Center, 501 72 Street, Miami Beach, FL 33141. A formal presentation will start at 6:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the projects.

The proposed work for these projects include:

Project: SR 934/Normandy Drive at Rue Granville

- Removing on-street parking to install a new crosswalk across Normandy Drive
- Installing overhead pedestrian warning signs
- Relocating the existing bus stop from the west side to a new open bus bay at the east side of the intersection
- Reconstructing curb ramps, installing curb extensions and enhancing lighting
- Repaving and restriping a segment of the roadway

Project: SR 934/Normandy Drive at Rue Vendome

- Removing on-street parking to install a new crosswalk at the signalized intersection of SR 934/Normandy Drive and Rue Versailles Drive
- Adding a raised median between Rue Vendome and Bay Drive along 71 Street
- Upgrading lighting and signage
- Widening the roadway and reconstructing the curb
- Repaving and restriping a segment of the roadway
