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## Park and Ride, I-95 and 95 Express Lane Closures

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**Miami, FL** – The following closures on I-95 and 95 Express will be scheduled as noted below to allow the contractor to replace Dynamic Message Signs:

Thursday, October 26 – One northbound I-95 general purpose lane will be closed from NW 173 Street to NE 177 Street between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Friday, October 27 (Saturday, October 28 is an alternate date) – The northbound 95 Express Lanes will be closed from the Golden Glades Interchange to Ives Dairy Road between the hours of 11 p.m. and 8 a.m. Two northbound I-95 general use lanes will also be closed from NE 170 Street to NE 177 Street between the hours of 11 p.m. and 8 a.m.

Saturday, October 28 – The entrance to the Golden Glades Park and Ride facility and access to NW 7 Avenue from northbound FL-9 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 8 a.m. Drivers can:

- Continue north on FL-9, turn right on NW 2 Avenue
- Turn right on NW 157 Street, turn left on NW 6 Avenue
- Turn right on NW 151 Street to access NW 7 Avenue
- Turn right on NW 7 Avenue to access the Golden Glades Park and Ride Facility

**Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.** The closures are part of the I-95 Design/Build Project to replace Intelligent Transportation Systems Devices (ITS) such as Toll Amount and Lane Status Dynamic Message Signs, Incident Management Dynamic Message Signs and cameras. The project will also install a Warning Gate System at the entrances to the 95 Express Lanes the Golden Glades Park and Ride Facility as well as SR 112.
