West Flagler Street Closed for Railroad Crossing Repairs

Miami, FL – Beginning at 6:00 a.m. on Thursday, November 16, 2017 until Friday, November 17, 2017 at midnight, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and CSX Transportation will close the railroad crossing located on State Road 968/West Flagler Street (near NW 71 Avenue) for these days, weather permitting. During this time, all traffic will be detoured away from West Flagler Street and directed to follow signs to alternate local roads.

This detour is being established to allow workers to perform construction to the CSX Railroad Crossing. During the closure, workers will replace the existing tracks and crossing surface to improve ride quality.

Detour Intent

West Flagler Street will be closed to vehicular traffic at CSX Railroad Crossing No. 631055E east of NW 71 Avenue.

Eastbound Detour:

Eastbound traffic on West Flagler Street will be directed to make a left at northbound NW 72 Avenue, a right at eastbound NW 7 Street, then traffic will make a right at southbound NW 57 Avenue and will continue until West Flagler Street.

Westbound Detour:

Westbound traffic on West Flagler Street will be directed to make a right at northbound NW 57 Avenue, a left at westbound NW 7 Street, then traffic will make a left at southbound NW 72 Avenue and will continue until West Flagler Street.
