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FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for two Roadway Projects

State Road (SR) 976/SW 40 Street/Bird Road from SW 117 Avenue to SW 102 Avenue

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public hearing for two roadway projects along SR 976/SW 40 Street/Bird Road from SW 117 Avenue to SW 102 Avenue, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in August 2020 and last 10 months. The estimated construction cost for these projects is about \$3.9 million.

The public hearing will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday, November 16, 2017, at the Miami Temple Seventh-day Adventist Church, Fellowship Room, 9175 SW 44 Street, Miami, FL 33156. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the projects.

The proposed work for these projects include:

- Extending the traffic separator and restricting southbound left-turn movements along SW 40 Street at SW 114 Avenue and at SW 113 Avenue
- Providing an additional westbound left-turn lane along SW 40 Street at SW 107 Avenue
- Upgrading traffic signals and signage
- Enhancing landscape
- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Reconstructing sidewalk and curb ramps
- Adjusting utility manholes
