Lane Closures on State Road (SR) 112 and I-95

Miami, FL – The following closures on SR 112 and I-95 will be scheduled as noted below to allow the contractor to install a Warning Gate System (WGS) for the northbound 95 Express Lanes and replace overhead message signs:

Friday, November 17 and Saturday, November 18 – One lane on eastbound SR 112 will be closed from NW 13 Avenue to east of NW 10 Avenue, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 11 a.m. One lane on the eastbound SR 112 ramp to northbound and southbound I-95 will also be closed during this time frame.

Friday, November 17 and Saturday, November 18 – Three general use lanes on northbound I-95 will be closed from NE 171 Street to NE 176 Street (one general use lane will remain open), between the hours of 11 p.m. and 8 a.m.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the I-95 Design/Build Project to replace Intelligent Transportation Systems Devices (ITS) such as Toll Amount and Lane Status Dynamic Message Signs, Incident Management Dynamic Message Signs and cameras. The project will also install a Warning Gate System at the entrances to the 95 Express Lanes the Golden Glades Park and Ride Facility as well as SR 112.
