State Road (SR) 94/SW 88 Street/Kendall Drive

Intersection Enhancement Project Begins the Week of January 8, 2018

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin an intersection enhancement project the week of January 8, 2018. The project limits extend along SR 94/SW 88 Street/Kendall at SR 985/SW 107 Avenue in Miami-Dade County. A Public Information Meeting will take place to discuss this project from **6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday, January 4, at Riverside Baptist Church, Room Fellowship Hall (FH), 10775 SW 104 Street, Miami, Florida 33176**. FDOT representatives will provide an overview of the project and will be available to answer questions.

The project will cost an estimated \$2.9 million. The work will take approximately eight months to be completed. The project includes the following:

- Upgrading drainage system along SW 107 Avenue
- Widening northbound and southbound SW 107 Avenue; repaving and restriping the intersection of SW 107 Avenue and Kendall Drive
- Modifying median and extending turn lanes at the intersection
- Upgrading signalization at the intersection, overhead signal heads and increasing signal timing
- Upgrading sidewalk, roadway signage and pedestrian ramps
- Trimming existing landscaping at the intersection
- Relocating the existing bus stop located south of the intersection on the east side of the roadway

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to periodically close lanes. Construction will be done in stages to minimize impacts to the public during special events and peak periods of traffic. The department will make sure traffic continues to flow safely through the work zones.
