State Road (SR) 7/US 441/NW 2 Avenue

Intersection Enhancement Project Rescheduled, Begins the Week of February 5

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has rescheduled the intersection enhancement project to begin the week of February 5, 2018. The project limits extend along SR 7/US 441/NW 2 Avenue and NW 199 Street in the City of Miami Gardens. The project will cost an estimated \$793,152. The work will take roughly five months to be completed. The project includes the following:

- Upgrading existing traffic signals to current standards
- Installing roadway signage
- Repaving and restriping the intersection
- Replacing sidewalks
- Upgrading existing intersection street lighting

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to periodically close lanes. Construction will be done in stages to minimize impacts to the public during special events and peak periods of traffic. The department will make sure traffic continues to flow safely through the work zones.
