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Safety Improvement Project Begins the Week of Feb. 12

State Road (SR) 90/US 41/SW 7 Street

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a safety improvement project the week of February 12, 2018. The project limits extend along SR 90/US 41/SW 7 Street from west of SW 25 Avenue to SR 5/US 1/Brickell Avenue in the City of Miami. The project will cost an estimated \$676,000. This project will last approximately six months and includes the following:

- Installing countdown pedestrian signals
- Updating pedestrian detectors, signals and ramps
- Adjusting utility tops along the sidewalk
- Repaving and restriping the road at various locations

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to temporarily close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
