Plantation Key Weigh Station Improvement Project Finishes on Schedule

Monroe County, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Six, has successfully completed the Plantation Key Weigh Station Improvement Project, located at Mile Marker (MM) 86 in Islamorada, Village of Islands, Monroe County.

Construction began on Monday, January 8, 2018 and was completed on Tuesday, February 27, 2018. The project cost was approximately \$1.1 million and it included the following work:

- Removing and reconstructing the existing pavement surrounding the Plantation Key Weigh Station pad and scale system
- Improving signage, pavement markings and lighting

The completion of this project demonstrates FDOT's continued commitment to improving the community's roads.
