## **FDOT to Host a Public Meeting**

*State Road (SR) 5/North Roosevelt Boulevard Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons and Lighting*

---

**Monroe County, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is conducting a pedestrian safety enhancement project which encompasses the design of pedestrian High-intensity Activated Cross Walks (HAWKs) and street lighting at five existing mid-block crossing locations along State Road (SR) 5/North Roosevelt Boulevard in the City of Key West, Monroe County, FL. The scope of work for this project is listed below. Construction is expected to begin September 2019 and last about seven months. The estimated construction cost for this project is about \$1.4 million.

**The Public Meeting will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, March 15, 2018 at the Monroe County Harvey Government Center, 1200 Truman Avenue, Key West, FL 33040. A formal presentation will start at 6:30 p.m.** Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the projects.

The proposed work for these projects include:

- Designing pedestrian HAWKs at five mid-block crossings
  - A. Near 24 North Hotel
  - B. Near Capital Bank
  - C. Near Key Plaza Shopping Center
  - D. Between 7 Street and Hilton Haven Road
  - E. West of 3 Street
- Upgrading pedestrian signing and pavement markings
- Upgrading street lighting
- Repaving and restriping the road
